

Form for Rule 18.6

NOTICE TO SHIPPERS

The Arkansas State Highway Commission requires that you be given this notice to read before having your goods moved.

UNLESS YOU EXPRESSLY RELEASE YOUR SHIPMENT AT 60¢ PER POUND PER ARTICLE, YOU WILL BE INSURED FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO YOUR SHIPMENT TO A SUM EQUAL TO \$1.25 TIMES THE TOTAL WEIGHT IN POUNDS OF YOUR SHIPMENT.

EXAMPLE

Your shipment weighs 4000 pounds, so the lump sum valuation is \$5,000 (\$1.25 times 4000 pounds). If the only damage to your shipment is a 100 pound television worth \$500 which has been totally destroyed, you may recover the full \$500. However, you will not be insured for loss exceeding \$5,000.

If you wish to be insured for more than \$1.25 per pound, you may declared a higher value on your shipment for an additional charge.

IF YOU RELEASE YOUR SHIPMENT AT 60¢ PER POUND PER ARTICLE, YOUR SHIPMENT WILL MOVE AT A SLIGHTLY LOWER COST, BUT THE CARRIER'S LIABILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE WILL BE LIMITED TO 60¢ PER POUND ON THE WEIGHT OF ANY ARTICLE ACTUALLY LOST OR DAMAGED.

EXAMPLE

If your color television worth \$500 and weighing 100 pounds is totally destroyed, you may recover only \$60 (60¢ times 100 pounds).

To release your shipment at "60¢ per pound per article," you must enter those words in a blank on the bill of lading.

IF YOUR EMPLOYER IS PAYING FOR THIS MOVE, BE SURE TO FIND OUT IF HE HAS INSURANCE TO PROTECT YOU IN CASE ANY OF YOUR GOODS ARE LOST OR DAMAGED. IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED AN ESTIMATE ON THIS SHIPMENT, YOUR ACTUAL TRANSPORTATION CHARGES MAY NONETHELESS BE HIGHER OR LOWER THAN THAT ESTIMATE.

Actual rates are determined strictly on a weight and mileage basis and are published in a tariff. If the actual charges on your shipment exceed the estimated charges by more than 10% you will be required to pay only the estimated charges plus 10% upon delivery of the shipment, but you will be allowed an additional fifteen (15) days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) to pay the balance of the actual charges.
