

## LGM's MOST EPICALLY COMPREHENSIVE Moving Checklist

8 W	leeks Before the Move
	Purge! If you haven't used it in 6 months, pitch it!
	<b>Research movers.</b> Most moving companies will give you a free quote in person or over the phone.
	If you are renting a truck, <b>book it</b> as early as possible! <b>Gather important records.</b> Put anything that can't be replaced (think prescriptions, legal
	documents, etc.) in a file to keep it safe.  Make travel arrangements. If your move involves air travel, vehicle rentals, or hotel
	stays, book now!  Order any new appliances. If you need a new dishwasher or fridge in your home, order it now so it has time to be delivered before move-in day.
6 W	Veeks Before
	<b>Hire specialty movers</b> for fragile, heavy, or expensive items such as art, gun safes, taxidermy, or pianos.
	Plan how best to move <b>personally valuable and sentimental items</b> . Is it best to keep certain items with you versus loaded onto the moving truck?
	<b>Ask about mover's insurance.</b> Make sure your movers' liability insurance will cover the replacement value of anything damaged.
	Coordinate with your utility company. Get your utilities turned off in your old home
	(post-move, of course) and turned on in your new home!  Call your children's schools. Alert new schools of the upcoming move, get enrollment
	information, and gather school records.  Make pet plans. Do you need a pet sitter? Will your furry friend need to be kenneled for
	a few days? Book these things now.
	<b>Get prepped for packing.</b> Make sure you have everything you need – boxes, packing tape, colored tape and markers for coding boxes, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, and scissors. Check with your mover to find out what they do and don't provide.
4 W	leeks Before
	Start packing seasonal and <b>seldom-used items</b> that you won't need to have on hand over the next month.
	<b>Keep track of hardware!</b> Items you disassemble can have tons of little pieces — screws, wall mounts, sconces, shelves — that can easily get lost. Put these in sealed plastic bags that you tape to the item themselves. Be careful to only affix bags to surfaces that cannot
	be damaged by the tape's adhesive.
	<b>Change your address.</b> Contact USPS to have your mail forwarded, and have your address changed for banks and credit card companies, magazines and newspapers, the DMV, and your employer. Notify your friends and family.
	Host a <b>moving sale</b> and <b>donate items</b> that aren't sold.
	Plan meals to <b>use up any perishable food</b> you can't take with you to your new place.
